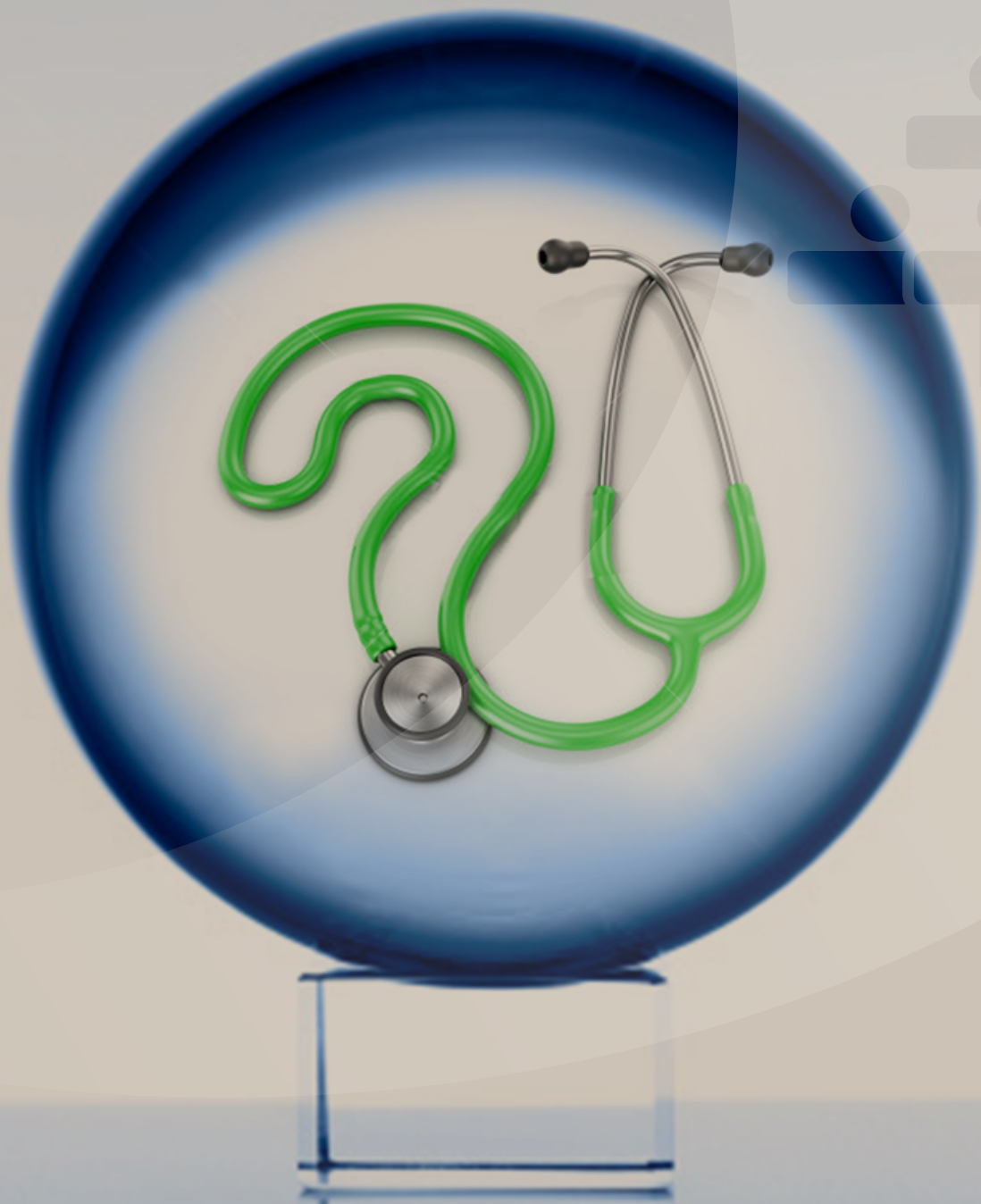

Entrants will be required to bring hard copies of their entry for display at the Winter Meeting. Photographs should be titled and will be allocated an A4 space (210 x 297mm) for display (orientation to match orientation of photographic entry), and poetry will be allocated an A3 space (297 x 420mm) in portrait orientation.
